1. Scope: This addendum covers the purchase of items in the *Electronic Monitoring of Offenders* contract lead by the State of Washington for use by state agencies and other entities located in the Participating State and authorized by that state's statutes to utilize state contracts with the prior approval of the state's Chief Procurement Official.

2. Participation: Use of specific NASPO (formerly WSCA-NASPO) cooperative contracts by agencies, political subdivisions and other entities (including cooperatives) authorized by an individual state's statutes to use state contracts are subject to the prior approval of the respective state Chief Procurement Official. Issues of interpretation and eligibility for participation are solely within the authority of the State Chief Procurement Official.

The State of Alaska is a NASPO Member State. The Department of Administration, Division of General Services, has the authority to sign NASPO Participating Addendums.

3. Participating State Modifications or Additions to Master Agreement: No changes are required.

4. Reporting: Contractor must submit quarterly reports to the State of Alaska Contacting Officer with an electronic usage report, which will list the purchasing entity, description of item(s) purchased, date, dollar amount, retail price, and extended price for each transaction. These reports are due within sixty (60) days of the end of a quarter in accordance with the Master Agreement.

First Quarter	July 1 through September 30
Second Quarter	October 1 through December 31
Third Quarter	January 1 through March 31
Fourth Quarter	April 1 through June 30

5. Purchase Order Instructions: Any Order placed by a Participating Entity or Purchasing Entity for a Product and/or Service available from this Master Agreement shall be deemed to be a sale under (and governed by the prices and other terms and conditions) of the Master Agreement unless the parties to the Order agree in writing that another contract or agreement applies to such Order. At a minimum, all orders should contain the following:

- a) **Mandatory Language, "This order is subject to NASPO Contract # 00212 terms, conditions, specifications and pricing."**
- b) **Your Name, Address, Contact, & Phone-Number.**
- c) **Other program requirements as necessary.**

6. Administrative Fees: Effective July 1, 2016, the Contractor agrees to provide an Administrative Fee to the State of Alaska for Participating Entities within Alaska.

a) **Contractor shall submit a check, payable to the State of Alaska, remitted to the Department of Administration, Division of General Services for the calculated amount equal to 1.5% of the net sales for the quarterly period for Participating Entities within Alaska.**

b) **Contractor must include the PA Number on the check. Those checks submitted to the State without the PA Number will be returned to Contractor for additional identifying information.**

c) **Administrative fee checks shall be submitted to:**

d) **The Administrative Fee shall be included as a 1.5% adjustment to Contractor's Master Agreement pricing as identified on Exhibit A, hereto that is inclusive of the 1.5% Administrative Fee. The contractor shall not reduce the discount percentages available under the master agreement to ordering agencies.**

e) **The Administrative Fee shall not be invoiced or charged to the ordering agency or identified on an ordering agency's invoice as a specified line item.**

f) **Payment of the administrative fee is due irrespective of payment status on any orders from a Purchasing Entity.**

g) **Administrative fee checks are due for each quarter as follows:**

8. Individual Customers: Each State agency and political subdivision, as a Participating Entity, that purchases electronic monitoring services will be treated as if they were Individual Customers. Except to the extent modified by a Participating Addendum, each agency and political subdivision will be responsible to follow the terms and conditions of the Master Agreement/Contract; and they will have the same rights and responsibilities for their purchases as the Lead State (State of Washington) has in the Master Agreement/Contract. Each agency and political subdivision will be responsible for their own charges, fees, and liabilities. Each agency and political subdivision will have the same rights to any indemnity or to recover any costs allowed in the contract for their purchases. The Contractor will apply the charges to each Participating Entity individually.

This Participating Addendum and the Master Agreement/Contract number 00212 (administered by the State of Washington as w6-2013) together with its exhibits, set forth the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter of all previous communications, representations or agreements, whether oral or written, with respect to the subject matter hereof. Terms and conditions inconsistent with, contrary or in addition to the terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Agreement/Contract, together with its exhibits, shall not be added to or incorporated into this Addendum or the Master Agreement/Contract and its exhibits, by any subsequent purchase order or otherwise, and any such attempts to add or incorporate such terms and conditions are hereby rejected. The terms and conditions of this Addendum and the Master Agreement/Contract and its exhibits shall prevail and govern in the case of any such inconsistent or additional terms within the participating state.

9. Order of Precedence: The parties acknowledge and agree that in the event of a conflict between the terms contained in the various documents comprising this Agreement, the following order of precedence will control: (a) this PA; (b) the Master Agreement, (c) any Purchase Order issued in connection therewith. This section specifically supersedes and order of precedence provision set forth elsewhere in the Agreement.
