Ms. Walsh,

The Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) received your request for records pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) on April 18, 2016. Specifically, you seek:

- 1. The number of driver's licenses that have been suspended for non-driving related drug offenses under Va. Code § 18.2-259.1 for the past three fiscal or calendar years for which data is available.
- 2. The number of these driver's licenses that have been reinstated following the expiration of the suspension period and receipt of the reinstatement fee under Va. Code § 18.2-259.1 for the past three fiscal or calendar years for which data is available.
- 3. The number of people who have been arrested for driving without a license after having their license suspended for a drug conviction under Va. Code § 18.2-259.1 for the past three fiscal or calendar years for which data is available.
- 4. The current fee to reinstate a driver's license suspended under Va. Code § 18.2-259.1 for a non-driving related drug offense.

I note from your correspondence that it appears you are located in the Massachusetts. Although FOIA does not require DMV to provide records to non-Virginia residents, it is the agency's policy to respond to such requests whenever feasible. As such, your request has been processed.

In response to Request Number 1, please find attached to this e-mail a file entitled "Response Request 1."

In response to Request Number 2, DMV does not possess any records reflecting the information you seek in the manner you have requested. The raw data needed to respond to your requests, however, is contained in DMV's computer database. DMV is able to compile data and run reports that would provide the information you seek in this request. To do so would require the expenditure of resources, for which DMV would charge a fee to recover its actual costs based on an hourly rate for the responding employee's time plus any programming, data and duplication costs. If you would like DMV to provide an estimate of the fee that would be charged to produce a report containing this information, please let me know.

In response to Request Number 3, DMV does not possess any responsive records because the agency does

not maintain information relating to arrests. The documents you seek may be maintained by the Supreme Court of Virginia. You may direct your requests to the following address:

Re: Open records request

Dear Ms. Walsh:

I am writing in response to your letter dated April 26, 2016 and received April 29, 2016. Your letter seeks, under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (VFOIA), "[t]he number of people who have been arrested for driving without a license after having their license suspended for a drug conviction under Va. Code Ann. § 18.2-259.1 for the past 3 fiscal or calendar years for which you have data available."

Please be advised that Virginia Code § 2.2-3703 (A)(5) provides that the VFOIA does not apply to "[t]he records required by law to be maintained by the clerks of the courts of record, as defined in § 1-212, and courts not of record, as defined in § 16.1-69.5." Accordingly, VFOIA is not applicable to your request. Furthermore, even if such court records were subject to VFOIA, only citizens of the Commonwealth of Virginia are guaranteed access under the Act. Va. Code § 2.2-3704 (A).

Nonetheless, we can search the electronic case records of the general district court for records that may be responsive to your request. If the records you are seeking are circuit court records, you must contact each circuit court clerk regarding access to that court's records. Contact information for circuit court clerks is available on Virginia's Judicial System website at <a href="https://www.courts.state.va.us">www.courts.state.va.us</a>.

You will be charged the cost to search for and provide the requested records. However, before any search can be completed, you will need to provide the Virginia Code section for the specific offense you are seeking. Please be advised that while

your request seeks the number of persons arrested, the records in the General District Case Management System will reflect the number of *cases* filed, and will not reflect the number of arrests or the total number of people who have been charged with such an offense.


