1. The Defendant shall contact Oklahoma Court Services, Inc. at 316 S. Peters, Norman, Oklahoma 73069, 405-321-6909, to initiate the fulfillment of sentence conditions and shall assist and cooperate fully with the Supervising Authority in the enforcement of the conditions contained herein together with any other special conditions lawfully imposed. The Defendant shall continue to report as directed to his/her Compliance Supervisor for the remaining portion of the pre-sentence supervision or the supervised term of deferment or probation.
2. The Defendant shall obey any additional directives and recommendations by staff of Oklahoma Court Services, Inc.
3. The Defendant shall notify his/her Compliance Supervisor within 48 hours of event to provide important information such as police contact or current address and telephone number changes.
4. The Defendant shall pay \$40.00 per month fees to Oklahoma Court Services for the term of the supervision.
5. The Defendant shall be supervised for [REDACTED] months / year (s);  Until all conditions listed are completed.
6. The Defendant shall remain lawful in conduct and refrain from violations of any criminal law of any jurisdiction.
7. The Defendant shall maintain full time employment unless excused by the Court or Oklahoma Court Services, Inc.
8. The Defendant shall pay \$ [REDACTED] JA / Fine, \$ [REDACTED] VCA, and all court costs including certified COI of \$ [REDACTED].  
 Instant;  Per Rule 8 agreement. The Defendant shall report to the Court Clerk in the Cleveland County Courthouse on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor before leaving today. The Defendant understands that failure to provide any and all current information that the Court Clerk requests and/or failure to make an agreement with the Court Clerk Administrator would cause payment in full to be due immediately and would be a violation of these rules and conditions of supervision.
9. The Defendant shall not consume or possess any controlled substance unless prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner.
10. The Defendant shall not consume or possess any alcoholic beverage for the term of his/her supervision.
11. The Defendant shall submit to random drug and alcohol surveillance techniques as requested and understands that the cost of such testing is at his/her expense.
12. The Defendant shall remain current on any child support order collected and enforced by the Oklahoma Child Support Enforcement Division.
13. The Defendant shall not possess a firearm as provided by federal law.
14. The Defendant shall permit his/her Compliance Supervisor, or designee of Oklahoma Court Services, Inc. to visit his/her residence, place of employment, or any other place without notice or restrictions as to time.
15.  The Defendant shall complete within 30 days **Domestic Violence Inventory Assessment** and follow its recommendations.
16.  The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days, attend weekly and successfully complete **counseling or treatment for domestic abuse by a qualified individual or a program certified by the Attorney General for a minimum of 52 weeks.**
17.  The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and successfully complete an **Anger Management Program.**
18.  The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo a **Substance Abuse Evaluation** and follow its recommendations.
19.  The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo a **Mental Health Evaluation** and follow its recommendations.
20.  The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and successfully complete **Parenting Skills Training.**
21.  The Defendant shall attend **G.E.D. training** and obtain a G.E.D. certificate.
22.  The Defendant shall pay **Restitution** through the DA's Office as directed, or as specified in a restitution agreement.
23.  The Defendant shall complete [REDACTED] hours of **Community Service** at a rate of not less than 20 hours per month.
24.  The Defendant shall serve [REDACTED] days in the Cleveland County Detention Center and shall surrender before [REDACTED] on [REDACTED], having a copy of the Commitment Order in Defendant's possession.  Credit for time served.
25.  The Defendant shall have **no contact with the victim.**
26.  The Defendant is required to report to the court on [REDACTED] for 120-day Compliance Review.

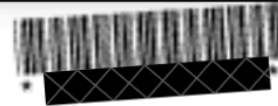

The Defendant shall contact **Oklahoma Court Services, Inc.** at 316 S Peters Ave. Norman, OK 73069 405-321-6909 to initiate the fulfillment of sentence conditions and shall assist and cooperate fully with the Supervising Authority in the enforcement of the conditions contained herein together with any other special conditions lawfully imposed. The Defendant shall continue to report to his/her designated Probation Supervisor for the remaining portion of the supervised term of probation.
2. The Defendant shall obey any additional directives and recommendations deemed necessary and appropriate by staff of Oklahoma Court Services, Inc.
3. The Defendant shall pay \$40.00 per month probation fees to Oklahoma Court Services, Inc. for the term of the supervised portion of probation.

10. **The Defendant shall submit to random drug and alcohol surveillance techniques as requested and understands that the cost of such testing is at his/her expense.**
11. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo a **Substance Abuse Evaluation** and follow its recommendations.
12. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo a **DUI Assessment** and follow its recommendations.
13. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and successfully complete a **Certified DUI School**.
14. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo a **Victim Impact Panel** and follow its recommendations.
15. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo a **Mental Health Evaluation** follow its recommendations.
16. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and undergo an **Anger Management Program** and follow its recommendations.
17. The Defendant shall enroll within 30 days and successfully complete **Ignition Interlock** for [REDACTED] months in any [REDACTED] automobile driven by defendant.
18. The Defendant shall complete [REDACTED] hours of **Community Service** at a rate of not less than 20 hours per month.
